# AUSDS Inc. TRIALS - Summary <br> Inc. No A0092012P <br> Fostering Excellence in Breeding Practical 'Utility’ Stock Dogs 

AUSDS Inc. Trials have been designed to test the working stock dog's instincts in all important areas of sheep and cattle work (as far as possible in a trial situation).

Most other trial designs tend to test a much more limited number of instincts. In many cases, this has resulted in dogs being bred with limited abilities that suit those trials, rather than true, high-class, allround utility dogs suited to the most challenging practical work.

Every AUSDS Inc. trial includes four aspects:
a. Long searching casts and mustering
b. Paddock and obstacle work (sheep)
c. Yard work (sheep)
d. Cattle work

The first two aspects are run in conjunction, then the yard and cattle aspects have separate courses and time limits.

The degree of difficulty increases with each level of trial. Level 1 is the easiest, followed by Level2, Level3, and Championship courses.

The course elements for each level are as follows:

1. Level 1 Trials (for handlers who have not won an AUSDS Inc. trial at a higher level; can only be won once)
a. and b. Combined Paddock (sheep)
i. 14 minutes; 3 sheep
ii. Minimum 200m cast; work sheep into handler's circle
iii. Force and Hold obstacle \& Heading obstacle
iv. Drive away minimum 40m
v. Work sheep through exit gate to complete segment
c. Yard (sheep)
i. 8 minutes; 8 sheep
ii. Drenching race; Draft; Load 3 sheep onto truck/trailer to complete segment
d. Cattle
i. 6 minutes; 3 cattle
ii. 1 obstacle; Put away to complete segment
2. Level 2 Trials (for dogs that have not won an AUSDS Inc. trial at a higher level; can be won twice)
a. and b. Combined Paddock (sheep)
i. 16 minutes; 5 sheep
ii. Minimum 300m cast; work sheep into handler's circle
iii. Force and Hold obstacle \& Heading obstacle
iv. Drive away minimum 6om
v. Work sheep through exit gate to complete segment
c. Yard (sheep)
i. 8 minutes; 10 sheep
ii. Drenching race; Draft; Load 5 sheep onto truck/trailer to complete segment
d. Cattle
i. 6 minutes; 3 cattle
ii. 1 obstacle; Put away to complete segment
3. Level 3 Trials (all dogs are eligible to compete)
a. and b. Combined Paddock (sheep)
i. 20 minutes; 5 sheep
ii. Minimum 400m cast
iii. Heading obstacle
iv. Drive away minimum 80 m
v. Force and hold obstacle with pen; Recast min. 200m onto 3 sheep to join with 5
vi. Work 1 sheep
vii. Work sheep through exit gate to complete segment
c. Yard (sheep)
i. 10 minutes; 13 sheep
ii. Drenching race; Draft; Load 8 sheep onto truck/trailer and Unload to complete segment
d. Cattle
i. 8 minutes; 3 cattle
ii. 2 obstacles; Put away to complete segment
4. Championship Trials (dogs must qualify in Open trials to be eligible to compete)
a. and b. Combined Paddock (sheep)
i. 22 minutes; 5 sheep
ii. Minimum 600m cast
iii. Heading obstacle
iv. Drive away minimum 120 m
v. Force and hold obstacle with pen; Recast min. 300m onto 5 sheep to join with 5
vi. Work 1 sheep
vii. Work sheep through exit gate to complete segment
c. Yard (sheep)
i. 10 minutes; 15 sheep
ii. Drenching race; Draft; Load 10 sheep onto truck/trailer and Unload to complete segment
d. Cattle
i. 8 minutes; 3 cattle
ii. 2 obstacles; Put away to complete segment
